She uses questions to engage audience's attention and thought such as "How do we start?" Then she uses an accumulative questions referring to the ~~are~~ events that occur in everyday life to show audience how to start to protect environment from their everyday life such as water saving, electricity saving.

She uses facts and figures to show the extent that environment has been degraded, such as "Every hour, there is one species face extinction, every year there are thousands of species..."

The authenticity of the ~~figure~~ numerical figure alarms the audience, and ~~shows them~~ she also use second person to directly urge audience to take action.
